Weatherization: Contracts for weatherization services have been sent out to the Community Action Agencies.

### **Summary of Recovery related meetings that the agency participated in**

Homeless: On July 1, 2009 MaineHousing staff met with grantees from the City of Portland and Cumberland County, sub-grantees from Preble Street and PROP and staff to collaborate and design the HMIS HPRP data sharing forms and intake assessments. Discussions also included the HPRP HMIS Data Sharing Agreements and the data sharing concepts with all HPRP sub-grantees statewide.

Weatherization: MaineHousing held a public hearing on July 9, 2009 to amend the ARRA Weatherization State Plan to select sub-grantees for the mid-coast community action region.

### **Summary of major agency communication related to the Recovery Act**

Homeless: MaineHousing received the Substantial Amendment HUD approval letter and next steps will be Grant agreements forthcoming from the HUD Field Offices in Manchester. No estimated dates were given on when the Grant Agreements are expected from the Field Office.

### **List of major actions taken to date related to the Recovery Act and major planned actions**

Homeless: Informational Forums for possible sub-grantees were held on July 7, 2009 at MaineHousing for both the Engagement & Stabilization and the Homeless Diversion and Prevention Programs. Potential sub-grantees were offered distance conferencing options for statewide coverage.
