- July 15 Survey results due from TA Providers
- July 22 Proposed Statement Sent for Printing
- August 15 Rulemaking Process Begins
- September 16 Public Hearing at Community Development Day
- September 26 Comments on Proposed Statement Due
- October 6 Rule Adopted
- October 14 Final Statement and Applications Published
- November 1-10 Application Workshops
- January 1, 2012 Program Begins per Final Statement

Maine CDBG in a Nutshell

- Applicants limited to Maine communities
- Lewiston, Auburn, Portland, Biddeford, Bangor & all of Cumberland County except Brunswick and Frye Island are not eligible
- Currently 12 programs are offered
- Funds must primarily benefit low and moderate income (LMI) persons
- LMI income limits set at 80% of county median & adjusted by family size
- Projects may benefit individuals & targeted groups depending on program and purpose

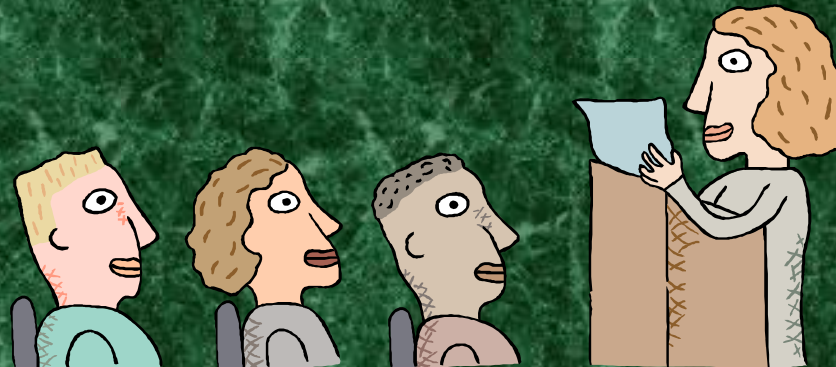
