

**MAINEHOUSING COMMISSIONERS MEETING & PUBLIC HEARINGS ON
SECTION 8 ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN AND
STATE PLAN FOR WEATHERIZATION RESCHEDULED**

The regular meeting of the Commissioners of the Maine State Housing Authority (“MaineHousing”), the public hearing on MaineHousing’s administrative plan for the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher and Project Based Voucher programs (the “Administrative Plan”), and the public hearing on MaineHousing’s proposed State Plan for 2013 for the U.S. Department of Energy – Weatherization Assistance Program (the “State Plan”) originally scheduled for Tuesday, March 19, 2013 have been rescheduled to 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 26, 2013 at MaineHousing’s offices at 353 Water Street, Augusta, Maine 04330.

The Administrative Plan sets forth MaineHousing’s policies for the operation of the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher and Project-Based Voucher programs in the context of federal laws and regulations. The public hearing to receive oral comments on proposed revisions to the Administrative Plan will be held at 9:30 a.m. on March 26, 2013. The draft Administrative Plan is available for inspection at MaineHousing’s offices in Augusta and on MaineHousing’s webpage: www.mainehousing.org. Written comments will be accepted until March 25, 2013.

The State Plan sets forth how MaineHousing will conduct its U.S. Department of Energy weatherization program from April 1, 2012 to March 31, 2014. The public hearing to receive comments on the proposed State Plan will be held at 11:30 a.m. on March 26, 2013.

The meeting and public hearings are open to the public. The meeting room is accessible to persons with physical disabilities and, upon sufficient notice, appropriate communication auxiliary aids and services will be provided for persons with disabilities. Upon sufficient notice, written materials provided in connection with the meeting will also be made available in alternative formats, such as large print or audio cassette.
