This MaineHousing Notice is being issued to provide clarification regarding the how HARP funds are being allocated to the CAAs and clarification regarding electronic project file deadline submission.

1. Revised HARP Guidance and Procedures (01/19/2023)

Added - Section B9.A: Allocated Funds

- (1) 2023 HARP funding will be divided into two (2) groups as follows:
 - a. Group 1 will include the following HARP components:
 - i. Home Repair
 - ii. Elderly Home Repair
 - iii. Emergency Home Repair
 - iv. Emergency Manufactured Home Repair
 - v. Accessibility
 - b. Group 2 will include Weatherization Readiness component
- (2) CAA funding will be allocated as follows:
 - a. Group 1 Allocation
 - i. Forty percent (40%) of the total Group 1 funding will be allocated for Home Repair and Elderly Home repair components.
 - ii. Sixty percent (60%) of the total Group 1 funding will be allocation for Emergency Home Repair, Emergency Manufactured Home Repair, and Accessibility.
 - b. Group 2 Allocation
 - i. Fifty percent (50%) of the total Group 2 funding will be allocated to weatherization jobs that were deferred before 01/01/2023.
 - ii. Fifty percent (50%) of the total Group 2 funding will be allocated to weatherization jobs that are deferred on or after 01/01/2023.

Clarification - Section B9.D: Submission Deadlines

- (1) All Phase 1 electronic file submissions, WSD, Emergencies, Accessibility and Weatherization Readiness, including invoices, are due to MaineHousing no later than November 1, 2023.
- (2) All Phase 2 electronic file submissions, WSD, Emergencies, Accessibility and Weatherization Readiness, including invoices, are due to MaineHousing no later than December 15, 2023.
