This MaineHousing Notice # 2025-HARP-004 is being issued to clarify that Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) funds cannot be used as leverage funds to advance a HARP project on the waitlist.

1. WAP funds cannot be leverage funds to move a HARP project up the waitlist

Home Repair and Older Adult Home Repair projects should be weatherized within six months of the completed HARP project, provided the client is eligible. If the full \$30,000.00 allocation for a Home Repair or Older Adult Home Repair project is not utilized, any remaining funds should be used to leverage the Weatherization (WAP) job.

However, **WAP jobs cannot be used to move a HARP applicant to the top of the waitlist**, as WAP funds do not qualify as leverage funds to expedite HARP projects.
