This MaineHousing Information Notice is being issued to replace MaineHousing Information Notice 2026-WAP-002, regarding ECOS conditional approval.

1. ECOS Approval

DOE has issued a memo to MaineHousing granting full, unconditional approval of ECOS for use on Site-Built Housing (SBH) up to four (4) units, as well as Manufactured Housing (MH). This ECOS approval is valid through April 1, 2030.

If CAA's have any Site-Built Housing jobs that were initiated in HEAT that contained a heat pump that could not be billed prior to the HEAT end date, you can now enter them into ECOS. These jobs must meet all required WAP criteria to be considered a completed WAP job in order to be billed.
